## Safety regulations on Hand Luggage

Dear Industry Colleagues,

As of 6 November 2006, the following safety regulations on hand luggage apply to all departures and onward flights from EU airports, including Iceland, Norway and Switzerland, in order to meet the requirements of the revised EU-wide Decree on Security Regulation No. 1546/2006 (Amendment of No.622/2003):

- Passengers may continue to carry liquids, gels and sprays in your hand luggage in packages of up to 100 ml in volume. These must be packed in transparent, resealable plastic containers of up to one litre in volume. One container is permitted per person.
- The exceptions to this are baby food, special dietary requirements (e.g. for medical purposes) and medication that is required during the flight. These items can be transported additionally to the plastic container.

The following items will be screened separately at security control:

- The transparent plastic container, with maximum volume of 100 ml each
- Laptops and electronic equipment (mp3 players, mobile phones, etc.)
- Jackets and coats
- All items purchased in airport shops

Please note: Items and containers not meeting these requirements may not be taken on board.

- All items purchased on board must be transported in a sealed plastic container and marked with the flight number and date. Cabin crew will be happy to assist with this. (This applies to purchases made on all aircraft registered in the EU, including all Austrian Airlines aircraft).
- In the event that other liquids are required and have been transported as part of check in luggage, please ensure these are securely packed for protection against knocks, leakage and breakage. Austrian Airlines does not accept liability for any damage to luggage that has been checked in.

Even stricter security regulations may apply on certain routes. These legal requirements are important for your safety! For this reason, Austrian Airlines recommends that all passengers take these requirements into consideration when planning their journey. We are doing everything within our power to ensure that your journey proceeds as smoothly and as pleasantly as possible.
